This is the second* Community Workshop to help shape the final design, character and look of Healdsburg Avenue - from Exchange Avenue to Mill Street, including the new Roundabout.

The purpose of this meeting will be to provide a technical review of how roundabouts work, and why a roundabout was chosen during the CHAP process as the preferred solution to the five way intersection at Healdsburg Avenue, Mill Avenue and Vine Street. Recognized experts from the project's lead consultant GHD, will be in attendance to explain how roundabouts function – and why they greatly improve vehicular and pedestrian safety, improve traffic flow, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions when compared to signalized intersections.
